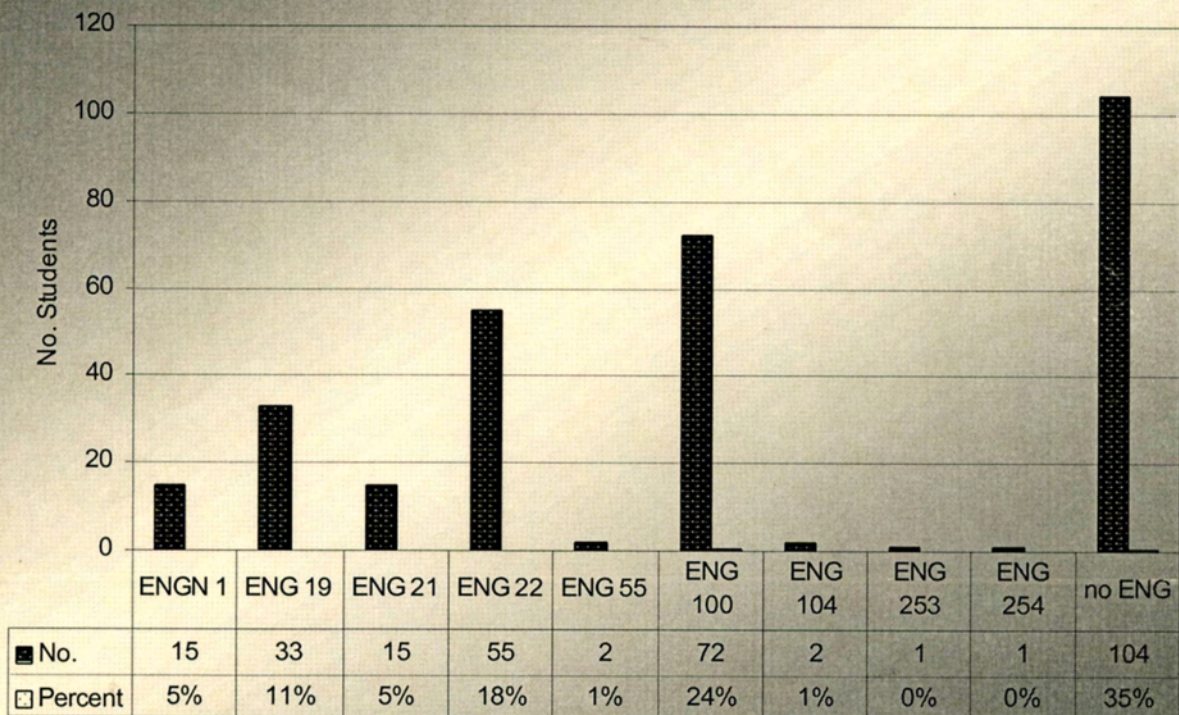


# Data Dialog on ENG course taken in 1<sup>st</sup> term by Liberal Arts Newcomers

## What are the findings? What to do?

ENG Course Taken in First Term (F04)  
by Liberal Arts Majors New to MCC



### Notes:

LibArts newcomers taking no ENG at all in the first term (F04) comprise about one-third (35%), and those taking some ENG in the first term comprise about two-thirds (65%).

The most frequent ENG course taken is ENG 100, taken by a fourth (24%) of the newcomers (3.6 sections).

The next most frequent ENG course is ENG 22, taken by 18% of the LibArts newcomers (2.8 sections).

Demand for ENG 19 was small (11%, consuming 1.7 sections).

Demand for ENG 21 was smaller (5%, consuming three-quarters of a single section).

Demand for ENGN 1-Basic Non-Credit English was also low (5%, consuming three-quarters of a single section).

Very few of these LibArts newcomers took ENG 55 (1%).

A few newcomers took ENG 104 and ENG Lit, course with an ENG 100 prereq. Did students complete ENG 100 elsewhere?
