

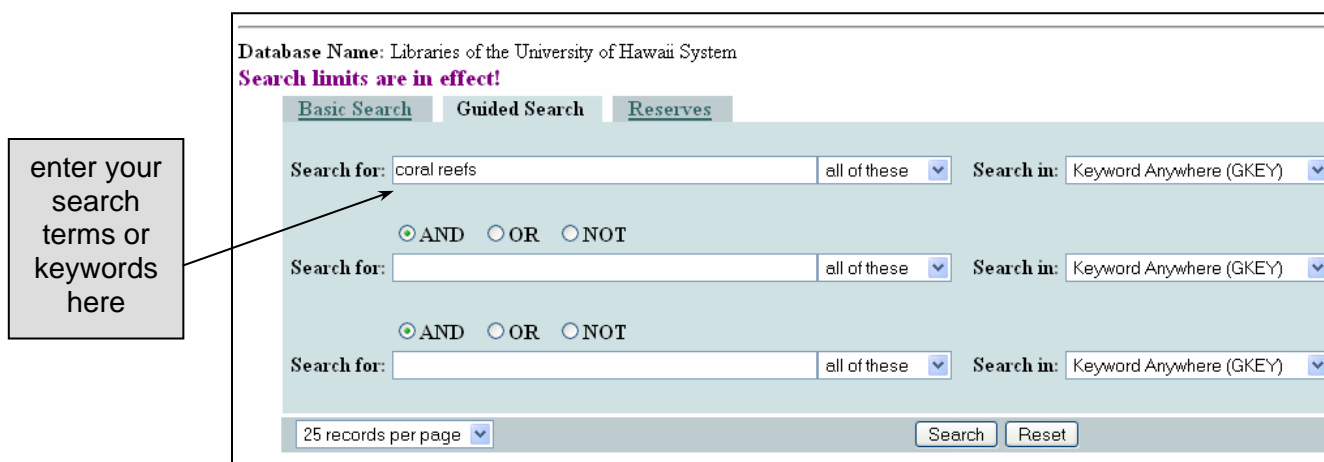
Using Hawai'i Voyager: Finding Books

Maui Community College Library

1. From any Internet-accessible computer (on or off campus), access the MCC Library Homepage at: www.hawaii.edu/maui/library/
2. Under the **SEARCH OUR COLLECTION** heading, click **Hawai'i Voyager**. The Hawai'i Voyager search screen appears.



3. From the search screen, enter your **search terms** (a keyword or phrase) in the first Search For box then click on the **Search** button at the bottom of the screen

5. From the results page, click on a record's **title** to retrieve the full record of the item.

► The results page lists the titles, authors, and publication dates of all items retrieved containing your search terms

6. Once you are at the full record screen:

- Scroll down the page until you see "Maui CC" in the **Location** field. Note that in this example, the item is also listed as being in the "Hawaiian" section of the MCC library
- Next, scroll down the page to view the **Status** of the item. The "Not Checked Out" status means that the item should be in the library
- Lastly, write down the entire **Call Number** and then go look for the item in its location
- Ask a librarian for help!
