UH Maui Community College Dental Assisting Program

The dental assisting certificate is a two-semester program that provides students with the skills needed to succeed in the dental profession. Accredited by the American Association Commission on Dental Accreditation (ADACODA), the Dental Assisting Program offers classroom instruction and hands-on clinical training at the Maui Oral Health Center and private dental offices on Maui.

Admission to the Dental Assisting Program is competitive. Qualified individuals are admitted based on grades in required courses, dental or other health care experience, and 100+ level science courses completed.

The following minimum competencies are required of students entering the Dental Assisting Program:

1. English 22 with grade C or better, or placement at English 100
2. Biology 100 with grade C or better
