- 1. <u>Attendance</u>. Chancellor Lui Hokoana convened the meeting of the Administrators Council at 9:30 a.m. Participating in the meeting were: Vice Chancellor Kahele Dukelow; T. Karen Hanada; Interim Vice Chancellor Kulamanu Ishihara; Brian Moto; Dean Laura Nagle; and Vice Chancellor David Tamanaha.
- 2. <u>Legislature</u>. Chancellor Hokoana discussed a proposed \$250,000 budget appropriation for adjunct faculty being considered by the Legislature. The Council discussed pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship programs.
- 3. MFIC. The Council discussed the recruitment of potential employees.
- 4. <u>DOE ALPSS</u>. Chancellor Hokoana will meet with UHCC and UH System leadership regarding the lease agreement.
- 5. <u>UHMC Positions</u>. David Tamanaha reported that UHCC may sweep vacant positions.
- 6. <u>DOE Security Matters</u>. David Tamanaha and the Council discussed recent security alerts on local DOE school campuses. The Council discussed possible draft messages to the UHMC community.
