UPDATE Today, Monday, Feb. 28th is the last day of free walk-in COVID testing on campus.

Starting tomorrow, Tuesday, March 1st, please call the Campus Health Center at 984-3493 to schedule an appointment to be tested. If you have medical insurance, please bring your medical card and ID when you come for testing. But you do not need medical insurance to get a test. The testing is free.

Please continue to be vigilant, wear your masks when you are around people, follow all COVID protocols, and please get vaccinated and get a booster when it's your time to get one. Stay safe and healthy!

UH President David Lassner delivered his monthly report to the Board of Regents on February 17 and said that COVID-19 boosters will not be required to work and attend UH and that current student and employee COVID-19 vaccination policies will remain in place through fall 2022.
