Everyone 18 years and older who has been vaccinated with either Moderna or Pfizer at least six months ago OR has been vaccinated with Johnson & Johnson at least two months ago is eligible for the booster.

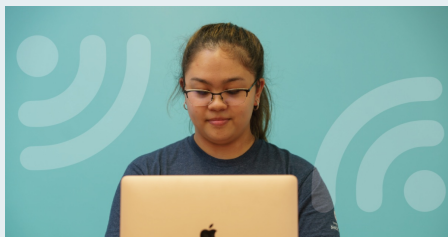

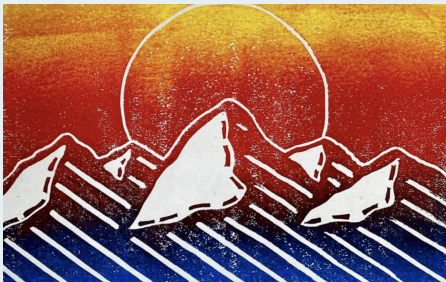
